NARRATIVE

SYNOPSIS:

On November 13th, 2017 Investigator Sean Sims along with the Hinds County Sheriff's Office Special Operations Division executed a narcotics search warrant at 528 Lexington Ave. in the city limits of Jackson, Mississippi. Patrick Carter and Lucy Carter were encountered during the execution and detained. The search of the residence revealed suspected marijuana, crystal methamphetamine, ecstasy, controlled prescription pills, set of scales and U.S. Currency. Patrick Carter claimed all narcotics and controlled substances and was taken into custody.

INVESTIGATORS BACKGROUND:

I, Investigator Sean Sims of the Hinds County Sheriff's Office, am assigned to investigate crimes involving the Mississippi Uniform Controlled Substance Act along with other violent crimes and effectively sworn to enforce local and state laws in Hinds County, as a sworn Investigator. I have received extensive training and gained invaluable experience in the field of narcotics enforcement, undercover techniques and human behavior as it relates to detecting deception as well as investigative interview techniques.

BASIS AND EXECUTION OF THE SEARCH WARRANT:

On November 13th, 2017, Investigator Lafayette Martin advised Investigator Sims that a confidential source provided him information about narcotics activity at 528 Lexington Avenue in Jackson, MS. Information provided stated that marijuana and methamphetamines were being distributed from this residence by Patrick Carter. Information was provided that within the last 24 hours marijuana and methamphetamine were seen in the residence. Based on the information a search warrant was obtained for the residence. The Richland Police Department Flex Unit joined to assist with the execution of the search warrant.

At approximately 17:00 Hours, the Hinds County Sheriff's Office Special Operations Division along with the Richland Police Department Flew Unit arrived at 528 Lexington Ave to execute the search warrant. Upon arriving at the residence, Sgt. Chapa and Investigator Martin activated the emergency blue lights on their Hinds County Sheriff's Office fully marked Police Tahoe. As Investigator Martin, Investigator Sims, and Investigator Brown approached the residence from the front yard and identified themselves as Law Enforcement Officers, Investigator Martin noticed that a black male quickly looked out the front window of the home. Capt. McLendon made forced entry through the window to ensure no ambush was awaiting the entry team or that no evidence was being destroyed. While on the porch of the residence, Investigator Sims could hear individuals running throughout the house. Investigator Sims determined through his training and experience that the individuals occupying the residence could be destroying evidence.

As Investigators made entry into the residence, the sound of flushing was heard coming from the rear of the residence. Investigators observed Patrick Carter and Lucy Carter coming from the rear of the residence in the same area as the flushing sound. While securing the residence, multiple narcotics

were observed in plain view in the kitchen and in the restroom. Once the residence and all occupants were secured, the residence was searched.

While searching the residence, Investigator Martin and Investigator Brown observed in the kitchen on the countertop bottles of prescription pills, Methamphetamine, packs of suboxone, packs of bunavail, and a backpack with 8 clear bags of suspected marijuana, digital scales, and sandwich bags.

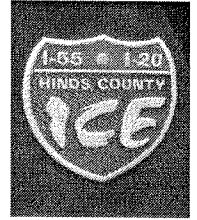
Investigator Sims observed two bags in the back bathroom toilet full of multi colored suspected MDMA pills that were attempted to be destroyed. Patrick requested a pair of jeans to be brought to him. Lucy Carter, Patrick's mother, brought a pair of black jeans. The jeans were searched in front of Patrick before they were handed to him. U.S. currency was located in Patrick Carter's front right pocket of the jeans with one (1) oxycodone pill. The bedroom that stored Patrick's clothe was searched and more currency was located in a jar along with multiple coins. Patrick Carter and Lucy Carter were issued a copy of the search warrant.

CONCLUSION AND EVIDENCE:

Sgt. Chapa advised Patrick Carter his Miranda Rights and Patrick acknowledged them. Patrick stated all the narcotics and currency belonged to him and not his mother. Patrick stated he has not had a job since he was out of jail in March. Patrick was transported to the Special Operations Office where a field was issued. Patrick was released and the investigation is ongoing. Charges pending for Patrick Carter are multiple counts of possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute.

All evidence was counted, weighed, and secured at the Hinds County Sheriff's Department. The U.S. Currency was secured at the bank for an official count of \$2,643.50 on November 14th, 2017. Patrick was issued a notice of intent to forfeit seized property. A seizure warrant for the currency was obtained and forwarded to MBN Jackson District.

NARRATIVE

SYNOPSIS:

On October 18th, 2017 Investigator Lafayette Martin along with the Hinds County Sheriff's Office Special Operations Division conducted a narcotics search warrant at 927 Lanier Avenue in the City limits of Jackson, Mississippi. While attempting to make entry to the residence, Jamerick Middleton attempted to jump through a window causing deep lacerations to his neck and chin. After his failed attempt to escape through the front window, Mr. Middleton assaulted 3 Investigators by pushing his way out the front door. While making his way off the front porch, Mr. Middleton violently pushed Investigator Nick Brown off the porch causing Investigator Brown to flip off the porch backwards. Due to Mr. Middleton's reckless actions, Investigator Brown's head violently went through a wooden support beam. Shortly after, Mr. Middleton was taken into custody after resisting arrest.

During a search of the residence, marijuana, cocaine, heroin, ecstasy, numerous prescription pills, scales, multiple cell phones and 4 firearms were recovered.

Subsequently, Jamerick Middleton, Larry Covington, Keith Spann, and Jeremy Spann were arrested for 5 counts of possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute while in possession of a firearm. Jamerick Middleton was also charged with Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer, 2 counts of Assault on a Police Officer, and Resisting Arrest. Larry Covington was charged with Convicted Felon in Possession of a Firearm. Approximately \$9,251.00 was recovered and seized from throughout the residence.

INVESTIGATORS BACKGROUND:

Investigator Lafayette Martin of the Hinds County Sheriff's Department, is assigned to conduct Criminal Interdiction, Investigate crimes involving the Mississippi Uniform Controlled Substance Act along with other violent crimes and effectively sworn to enforce local and state laws in Hinds County, as a sworn Investigator. Investigator Martin has received extensive training and gained invaluable experience in the field of narcotics enforcement, criminal interdiction, narcotics K9 handling, undercover techniques, and human behavior as it relates to detecting deception as well as investigative interview techniques.

BASIS OF INVESTIGATION:

On October 18th, 2017 Sr. Investigator Lafayette Martin call sign Kilo-3, received information from a confidential informant in reference to a large amount of cocaine and marijuana being distributed and sold from 927 Lanier Avenue near Ludlow Avenue in the City Limits of Jackson, Mississippi. The information obtained was that an unknown black male occupying the residence was currently in possession of a large amount of cocaine with the last 24 Hours. The unknown black male was also said to drive a dark blue in color Honda sedan with a Mississippi registration and is known to carry a firearm while selling illicit narcotics from the living room of 927 Lanier Avenue Jackson, Mississippi.

Based on this information, Sr. Investigator Lafayette Martin requested and obtained a search warrant be executed for any controlled substances, paraphernalia related to the sales/trafficking of a controlled substance and any U.S. Currency or other monetary instruments derived from the sale/trafficking of

controlled substances, with the search warrant included any vehicles, outbuildings, safes, electronic devices, or locked containers found on the property of 927 Lanier Ave.

SEARCH WARRANT:

At approximately 2000 Hours, Investigator Martin along with the Hinds County Sheriff's Office Special Operations Division arrived at 927 Lanier Avenue to execute the search warrant. Upon arriving at the residence, Sgt. Chapa and Lt. Thornton activated the emergency blue lights on their Hinds County Sheriff's Office Fully Marked Police Tahoe. As Investigator Martin, Investigator Sims, and Investigator Brown approached residence from the front yard and identified themselves as Law Enforcement Officers, Investigator Martin noticed that a black male quickly looked out the front window of the home. While on the porch of the residence, Investigator Martin could hear several individuals frantically running throughout the house and the toilet flushing continuously. Due to Investigator Martin training and experience, it was determined that the individuals occupying the residence were attempting to flush and/or dispose of illicit narcotics.

Due to the information received in reference to the unknown violator carrying a weapon while selling narcotics and the occupants frantically running throughout the house, Investigator Martin made initial entry through the front window of the residence for officer safety/visibility. After Investigator Martin made entry through the window for officer safety, Investigator Martin observed a black male, later identified as Larry Covington, run from the front couch to the back bedroom. As Mr. Covington ran from the couch, Investigator Martin observed a black in color handgun on the couch next to where Covington was sitting in plain view.

Investigator Sims and Investigator Brown later made forced entry into the residence through the front door. While entering the residence, a black male later identified as Jamerick Middleton attempted to jump through the front window but was pulled back in by Investigator Sims. Due to Mr. Middleton's reckless attempt to jump through the window, he sustained one laceration on his chin and one laceration on his neck. After being non compliant and resisting arrest, Mr. Middleton ran out the front door where he pushed Investigator Martin and Investigator Brown off the front porch. Due to Mr. Middletons reckless actions and violent attempted escape, Investigator Brown was pushed through a wooden support beam, causing his head to knock the beam off the house and Investigator Brown to flip backwards off the porch. Investigator Brown appeared to have been knocked unconscious for a brief moment. As Mr. Middleton fled on foot through the front yard, Sgt. Chapa deployed his Hinds County Sheriff's Office issued Taser. After deploying the taser, Mr. Middleton was taken into custody.

Investigator Martin and Investigator Sims later cleared the house to locate the other 3 males that were running throughout the home. After entering the residence, Larry Covington was located near the bathroom toilet, where he was observed flushing narcotics by Investigator Sims. Keith Spann was located in the living room area where he was attempting to flee out the back door, and Jeremy Spann was located in the kitchen area where he believed investigators were still outside with Mr. Middleton. As Investigator Martin entered the back bedroom, he noticed Jeremy Spann was attempting to flee out the back door of the residence. Investigator Martin ordered Jeremy Spann to the ground but Mr. Spann failed to comply. Due to Mr. Spann failing to comply to verbal orders, Investigator Martin used the least amount of force necessary by deploying his Hinds County Sheriff's Office issued Taser. After deploying the Taser, Mr. Spann was taken into custody.

After all the occupants of the residence were secured, Investigators started a complete search of the residence.

RESIDENCE SEARCH:

During a search of the front living room, Investigator Martin observed a black in color Sig Sauer handgun (Serial Number EAK124660) on the front living room couch. This handgun was next to Larry Covington during the initial entry. A silver in color Smith and Wesson .38 special revolver (Serial Number 3733) was located in the front living room, inside the top drawer of the TV stand.

After completing the search of the living room, Investigator Martin began to search the kitchen and observed an orange clear pill bottle containing a brown substance believed to contain suspected heroin and a clear bag containing a green leafy substance suspected to be marijuana, in the far right kitchen cabinet on the bottom shelf. One black cell phone and a case of bullets were located on the middle shelf of the cabinet. As Investigator Martin stood on the counter to complete the search of the cabinet, Investigator Martin observed one clear bag containing multiple colored pills believed to be MDMA, a clear bag containing a brown like substance believed to be heroin, and a clear bag containing a white substance believed to be cocaine.

While searching the back bedroom of the residence, a large sum of U.S. Currency was located next to the bed in a white plastic container and a black in color FN handgun (Serial Number GKU0025192) was observed on the bed along with a white cell phone. As Investigator Martin opened the bedroom closet door, he noticed a white plastic bag containing a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana and a large sum of U.S. Currency in a shoe box.

During a search of the front bedroom of the residence, a Cobray M11 (89-0014615) was observed in the bottom dresser drawer and a large sum of U.S. Currency was located in the top drawer in a black box. There was also numerous papers with Jeremy Spann's name and Jamerick Middleton's driver's license was observed in the bedroom closet.

CONCLUSION AND EVIDENCE:

Subsequently, Mr. Middleton was taken to the hospital by AMR and was over seen by Investigator Nick Brown and later transported to the Raymond detention center for Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Marijuana), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (cocaine), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Heroin), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (MDMA), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Vyvanse), Aggravated Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer, Two (2) Simple Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer, and Resisting Arrest.

Jeremy Spann and Keith Spann were arrested for Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Marijuana), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (cocaine), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Heroin), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (MDMA), and Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Vyvanse).

Larry Covington was arrested for Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Marijuana), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (cocaine), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Heroin), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (MDMA), Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (Vyvanse) and Convicted Felon in Possession of a Firearm.

All evidence was placed into bags and sealed. The U.S. Currency was also sealed and placed in a safe at the Hinds County Sheriff's Office where it was taken to the bank for an official count on October 19th, 2017. The official count of the U.S. Currency was \$9,251.00 . Jeremy Spann, Keith Spann, Jamerick Middleton, and Larry Covington were issued a copy of the search warrant and a notice of intent to forfeit seized property. Sgt. Obtained a Seizure warrant for the currency and the firearms and forwarded the warrant to MBN.

NARRATIVE

SYNOPSIS:

On October 3rd, 2017, Sgt. Juan Chapa was contacted by Captain Nick McClendon of the Richland Police Department in reference to a package that was intercepted at FEDEX in Richland, MS containing approximately 6.5 Pounds of Marijuana. The package was to be delivered to 5518 Deckard Street in Jackson, MS 39209. Units acting in an undercover capacity delivered the package to the front door of 5518 Deckard after no answer. Units observed a large black male exit the garage of the residence and quickly grabbed the box from the front door and returned to the garage and closed it. Units arrived at the residence and made contact with Rodrick Gladney and Amber Woods. Rodrick stated he had a gun in the vehicle, approximately one (1) pound of marijuana in his bed room and approximately \$2,200.00 in U.S Currency in the residence. Both Amber and Rodrick gave verbal consent to search the residence. A search of the property revealed approximately 1.5 pounds of marijuana, the package containing the initial marijuana, \$2,511.00 in U.S. Currency and a 9mm Glock. Both Rodrick and Amber were taken into custody and charged for possession with intent to distribute.

INVESTIGATORS BACKGROUND:

I, Sergeant Juan Chapa, of the Hinds County Sheriff Department Special Operations Group, am assigned to conduct Criminal Interdiction, Investigate crimes involving the Mississippi Uniform Controlled Substance Act along with other violent crimes and effectively sworn to enforce state and local laws in Hinds County, as a sworn Deputy Sheriff Investigator. I am also sworn as a Federal Task Force Agent to enforce Federal Laws under Title 21 with DOJ/DEA Group 51 of the Jackson District Office. I have received extensive training and gained invaluable experience in the field of narcotics enforcement, criminal interdiction, narcotics K9 handling, undercover techniques, Supervising Narcotic Groups, and human behavior as it relates to detecting deception, as well as investigative interview techniques. I also conduct undercover operations to include prostitution, narcotics and child sex crimes.

BASIS OF THE INVESTIGATION:

On October 3rd, 2017, Sgt. Juan Chapa was contacted by Captain Nick McClendon of the Richland Police Department FLEX Unit. Capt. McClendon advised that Investigator Steed had located a shipment of suspected marijuana at the FEDEX in Richland, MS during a search warrant. Sgt. Chapa and Capt. McClendon agreed on a control delivery and assisted and executing the delivery.

CONTROLLED DELIVERY:

At approximately 9:10 A.M. Capt. McClendon, acting in an undercover capacity, responded to 5518 Deckard in Jackson, MS 39209. The package showed the delivery address of 5518 Deckard along with the name Donte Rowe. Capt. McClendon arrived at the residence and knocked on the front door with no answer. Capt. McClendon placed the package at the door and departed the residence. Inv. Nick Brown with the Hinds County Sheriff's Department Special Ops Unit parked across the street from the residence and was able to have visual of the front of the residence. Moments later Inv. Brown advised Sgt. Chapa that a large black male was coming out of the garage and was approaching the package at the front door. Inv. Brown observed the male grab the package and walk back into the garage.

CONTACT WITH RODRICK GLADNEY AND AMBER WOODS:

Upon the male, who was later identified as Rodrick Gladney, grabbing the package and returning into the residence, units responded and arrived to the residence to execute an arrest. As Sgt. Chapa approached the front door, he observed a male standing in the living room through the front window. Sgt. Chapa began announcing and identifying himself as the Sheriff's Department and began ordering the male to exit the residence. Gladney exited the residence through the garage and Inv. Brown confirmed that it was the same male that came out and grabbed the package. Sgt. Chapa and Inv. Brown made entry into the residence to secure the evidence. As entry was made into the residence from the garage, Sgt. Chapa again announced law enforcement presence and observed a female walking out of the master bed room towards the living room. The female, who was identified as Amber Woods, was carrying an infant and was ordered to sit on the couch as the rest of the residence was secured. Once the residence was secured, both Gladney and Woods were advised of their rights by Sgt. Chapa.

INTERVIEW OF GLADNEY AND WOODS AND REQUEST FOR CONSENT TO SEARCH:

Gladney stated he moved to this address approximately six (6) months ago from Washington State. Gladney stated he smokes marijuana every day and that he had one (1) pound of marijuana in his bed room. Gladney stated he had a gun and a small amount of marijuana in his truck. Gladney stated he transported three (3) pounds of marijuana from Washington State when he moved to Jackson, MS and that the pound in his room is what is left over. Gladney advised he did not know what was in the box and that he only took it inside because it was at his door. Gladney advised the residence and both vehicles in the drive way could be searched. Gladney advised on audio that his consent was given without threats, coercion, or under duress. Gladney advised he placed \$1000.00 in the living room sofa inside a plastic bag. Gladney advised there was over \$2,200.00 in cash in the residence. Gladney stated he and Woods smoke marijuana together and that the only job he has is selling food without a health permit. Gladney did state that he sells marijuana to his friend's periodically.

Amber Woods is Gladney's live in girlfriend and mother to his child. Woods stated she smokes marijuana and that she is from Washington State where marijuana is legal. Woods acknowledged and stated that she is aware of marijuana being illegal in the State of Mississippi. Woods gave verbal consent to search the residence. Woods advised on audio that her consent was given without threats, coercion, or under duress. Amber stated she works at Papitos Restaurant in Madison and that the cash is from her tips.

SEARCH OF THE RESIDENCE

Upon searching the residence, multiple clear plastic bags that contained marijuana residue along with U.S. Currency was located in the center storage area of the couch in the living room. Approximately \$1000.00 was located in a bag that also had a strong odor of marijuana. A black scale was also located in the storage area. In the Kitchen, a diaper bag was located hanging from a dinner table chair that contained one small bag of suspected marijuana, a scale, and a grinder. In the master bedroom closet, a shoe box was located containing two (2) packages wrapped in the same manor and tape as the packages in the delivery box. The packages contained suspected marijuana. More currency was located In the dresser next to the bed in the master bed room. The delivery box was located in the living room next to the coffee table which had a small round brown ball which was described as strong marijuana by Woods. In the black F150 located in the drive way, a Glock 9mm was located in the driver door. A marijuana joint was located in the ashtray and a small bag of marijuana was located in the center console. Another joint was located in an ashtray in the garage.

CONCLUSION & EVIDENCE:

William Gladney arrived on location and took custody of the infant child with the consent of Woods. All evidence was collected and secured by Sgt. Juan Chapa and was taken and placed in evidence at the Hinds County Sheriff's Department located at 407 E. Pascagoula Street Jackson, MS 39201. Total weight of marijuana was approximately eight (8) Pounds. Total currency seized was \$2,511.00. The Glock 9mm was also seized. Both Gladney and Woods were given a forfeiture notice. Gladney was taken into custody and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance with intent to Distribute while in Possession of a Firearm. Woods was taken into custody and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute. Both Gladney and Woods were taken and placed in Jail at the Raymond Detention Center in Raymond, MS where they were left in their care and custody. The currency was deposited into a secure bank account.

On October 4th, Sgt. Juan Chapa secured a Seizure Warrant for the currency and the firearm and provided a copy to MBN.

NARRATIVE

SYNOPSIS:

On September 12th, 2017 at approximately 0200 Hours, Investigator Lafayette Martin K-3 (Kilo Three) observed a white in color Dodge Avenger displaying Texas registration JTK6625 on I-55 Southbound near County Line Road traveling at a high rate of speed (80MPH in a 60MPH zone). The white in color Dodge Avenger attempted to exit the Interstate as the driver noticed Investigator Martin's fully marked Sheriff's Department Tahoe trailing from behind. Investigator Martin utilized his vehicle's calibrated speedometer to check the speed of the white in color Dodge Avenger.

Investigator Martin conducted a traffic stop on this vehicle for the traffic violation of speeding on I-55 Southbound near the Adkins Road exit in Hinds County, Mississippi. During the course of the traffic stop, the driver, Rodolfo Zarate, displayed extreme nervousness, and gave conflicting travel itineraries. While Investigator Martin wrote Rodolfo Zarate a written warning, Zarate stated he had been arrested for transporting 30 (thirty) pounds of marijuana in Texas through a U.S. Border Patrol Checkpoint previously. Zarate later gave verbal consent to Investigator Martin to conduct a search of the vehicle.

Due to the extreme nervousness and conflicting travel itinerary, Investigator Martin believed criminal activity was present. Investigator Martin later searched the vehicle and observed 2 (two) packages hidden under the driver's side dashboard. These packages were wrapped in black duct tape and concealed in a manner in which drug trafficking organizations utilize to illegally traffic narcotics and narcotics proceeds on major U.S Highways. After Investigator Martin open the packages, it was later

determined to be a large sum of U.S. Currency. Through Investigator Martin's training and experience, Investigator Martin believed that the currency was illegal drug proceeds due to the extreme nervousness of the driver/passenger, the manner in which the U.S. Currency was wrapped, and the manner in which the U.S. Currency was hidden inside the vehicle.

During an interview of both the driver and passenger, neither could produce any documentation as to where the U.S. Currency came from or financial records to coincide with a withdrawal from a financial institution. Hinds County K-9 (Dex) also gave a positive odor response to the odor of narcotics to the White in color Dodge Average and the packages of U.S. Currency.

INVESTIGATORS BACKGROUND:

Investigator Lafayette Martin of the Hinds County Sheriff's Department, is assigned to conduct Criminal Interdiction, Investigate crimes involving the Mississippi Uniform Controlled Substance Act along with other violent crimes and effectively sworn to enforce local and state laws in Hinds County, as a sworn Investigator. Investigator Martin has received extensive training and gained invaluable experience in the field of narcotics enforcement, criminal interdiction, narcotics K9 handling, undercover techniques, and human behavior as it relates to detecting deception as well as investigative interview techniques.

THE TRAFFIC STOP:

On September 12th, 2017 at approximately 0200 Hours, Investigator Lafayette Martin call sign K-3 (Kilo Three) observed a white in color Dodge Avenger displaying Texas registration (JTK6625) traveling on I-55 Southbound near County Line Road (Hinds County) at a high rate of speed (80MPH in a 60MPH zone). Investigator Martin utilized his vehicle's calibrated speedometer to check the speed of the white in color Dodge Avenger. As the driver of the vehicle observed Investigator Martin trailing from behind in his fully marked Police Tahoe equipped with blue lights and sirens, the driver sped up and quickly attempted to exit off of I-55 near the Adkins Road exit in an attempt to evade Investigator Martin.

After Investigator Martin activated his emergency equipment to initiate a traffic stop for the traffic violation of speeding, the vehicle stopped on the shoulder of I-55 Southbound near the Adkins Road exit. Investigator Martin exited his Tahoe and approached the white in color Dodge avenger on the driver's side and made contact with the driver of the vehicle who was later identified as Rodolfo Zarate. Investigator Martin explained to Zarate that he was stopped for the traffic violation of speeding (80 MPH in a 60 MPH Zone) and he would receive a written warning for the violation. Due to the vehicle's being stopped on I-55 close to passing traffic, Investigator Martin had the driver step to the rear of the vehicle with his driver's license. Zarate handed Investigator Martin a Texas Identification card and exited his vehicle.

ENFORCEMENT ACTION & REASONABLE SUSPICION FOR CONTINUED DETENTION:

While standing in the front of Investigator Martin's vehicle, Zarate stated he was returning to the valley (Mission, Texas) from Memphis, Tennessee. Zarate stated his girlfriend's family was stranded in Memphis so they had to take a trip to Tennessee. While Investigator martin spoke to Zarate, he observed that Zarate did not possess a valid driver's license, hands were shaking tremendously, his breathing was heavy, and he moved from side to side uncontrollably. Investigator Martin made contact with the passenger who was identified as Jaqueline Pina. Pina stated they were coming from Ohio. While Investigator Martin spoke with Pina, he noticed that her breathing was very heavy and her hands were shaking tremedously. When Investigator Martin asked Pina how long they were in Ohio, Pina

responded by saying "Oh we were just going". Pina later stated about a day in a half. Pina handed Investigator Martin a Texas Identification Card. Through Investigator Martin's training and experience, Investigator Martin believed that both Pina and Zarate were attempting to deceive him by giving a false travel itinerary. As Investigator Martin began to write Zarate a warning for the traffic violation of speeding, Investigator Martin asked Zarate had he previously been in trouble before. Zarate stated he was arrested for attempting to traffic thirty (30) pounds of marijuana through the Falfurrias check point in Falfurrias, Texas . Zarate also stated that he was used as a decoy car so that the car in front of him could go through the checkpoint without being searched.

REQUEST FOR CONSENT:

Due to the totality of the circumstances of conflicting stories, attempted deception, extreme nervousness, and conflicting travel itineraries, Investigator Martin believed criminal activity was present. While in the front of Investigator Martin's vehicle, Investigator Martin asked Zarate if there was anything illegal in the car. Zarate stated "No Sir, you can go ahead and search the vehicle".

VEHICLE SEARCH:

After receiving voluntary consent to search the vehicle from Zarate, Investigator Martin removed Pina from the vehicle and began searching on the driver's side of the vehicle. While searching under the driver's side dashboard, Investigator Martin observed what appeared to be two (2) bundles wrapped in black duct tape hidden the air conditioning housing unit. Through Investigator Martin training and experience, these packages were wrapped in black duct tape and concealed in a manner in which drug trafficking organizations utilize to illegally traffic narcotics and illicit narcotics proceeds on major U.S. Highways. Before determining removing the packages, Investigator Martin detained both subjects until further investigation. Investigator Martin returned to the Dodge Avenger and opened one end of one bundle. Investigator observed that the bundle contained a large amount of U.S. Currency. Investigator Martin left the bundle of Currency on the floor board. Investigator Martin immediately contacted LT. Thornton and Sgt. Chapa of the U.S. Currency and called for additional units to assist. Sgt. Chapa later arrived on the scene of the traffic stop and assisted with transporting the vehicle to the Hinds County Sheriff's Special Operations Office for evidence processing.

CONCLUSION & EVIDENCE:

After arriving at the Special Operations Office, Sgt. Chapa interviewed Zarate and Pina while investigator Martin processes the vehicle. While processing the vehicle, Investigator Martin utilized Hinds County Sheriff's Office K-9 Dex to conduct an exterior sniff of the vehicle for the odor of narcotics. While conducting the exterior sniff of the vehicle, K-9 Dex gave a positive odor response to the front right passenger wheel well and the left rear passenger door. This positive odor response was recorded by Investigator Martin's Police Tahoe's dash camera. Investigator Martin observed a black in color flip cellphone located in driver's door and 2 (two) touch screen cellphones located on the center console.

After Sgt. Chapa interviewed Zarate and Pina, the U.S. Currency was counted and Pina was issued a Notice of Intent. The total U.S. Currency in both bundles and Currency related to the bundles was a total of \$16, 720.00. Zarate was issued a written warning for the traffic violation. Zarate and Pina were both released but not allowed to leave in the vehicle due to not having a valid driver's license.

On the 28th day of June 2018 at approximately 2240 hours, Inv. Keith Burnett Jr and Inv. Nick Brown, assigned to the Hinds County Narcotics Division, along with other officers and Detectives from the Jackson Police Department conducted surveillance on 304 Southbrook Dr Jackson, MS 39211 due to an on going investigation of possible illegal drug activity at the said residence.

While conducting surveillance, Inv. Burnett observed a black Dodge Charger park in front of said address and turn off its headlights. After a short time Investigator Burnett observed an unidentified black male exit the residence and walk to the vehicle and stand outside the passenger side window. The black male stood outside the vehicle for approximately 2 minutes before returning inside the home. The vehicle immediately pulled away from the residence as the unidentified male left the vehicle.

Inv. Burnett conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and came in contact with the black male driver. Upon approaching the vehicle, Inv. Burnett observed the strong odor of suspected "raw" marijuana coming from the vehicle. Inv. Burnett asked the driver to exit the vehicle and observed in plain view a clear bag of green leafy substance, suspected marijuana, inside the pocket of the driver door.

The driver of the vehicle gave a verbal and written statement stating he met a black male, he identified as "JD" at Chevron on Ridgewood Rd. The driver stated "JD" walked to his car and asked "do you smoke because I got it on 'deck'". The driver stated "JD" gave a contact number of "(769)216-4015". The driver stated he contacted "JD" and was given the address of 310 Southbrook to come purchase the marijuana. The driver stated he went to the residence at which time "JD" came out of the residence next door, later identified as 304 Southbrook Drive, and "served" him \$10 of Marijuana.

On the 29th day of June 2018 at approximately 1628 hours, Investigator K. Burnett, Jr. along with other Hinds County Sheriff's Office Deputies and JPD Detectives arrived at 304 Southbrook Dr. with a search warrant for the residence in reference to narcotics. Upon arriving officers detained a black male, later identified as Jessie Wilder, who was sitting in a parked vehicle in the front yard. Wilder was identified as the black male, "JD", who sold the individual driving of the Dodge Charger suspected marijuana on June 28, 2018. Upon entering the residence, Inv. K. Burnett and other officers secured the scene for safety purposes, and all persons were escorted outside the residence (3 black females and 3 juvenile black males).

Inv. Burnett began a search of the residence once it had been secured. Inv. Burnett observed multiple clear bags of green leafy substance believed to be marijuana on the table in the front living room as you immediately entered the doorway. There were also 10 multi-colored pills, suspected to be ecstasy (MDMA) pills, on the same table. Inv. Burnett also observed \$115.00 U.S. Currency on the same table laying next to the suspected narcotics. Inv. Burnett continued to the far back left bedroom, and observed the following inside the closet: Springfield XD .40 cal, Mossberg 715T .22LR, Savage 949 .410 with sawed off barrel, Norinco SKS 7.62x39, Springfield 67D 12ga, Rossi .38 special, and a bundle of U.S. Currency totaling \$1628.00 bound with a rubber band. Inv. Burnett ran the serial numbers to the above said firearms through Hinds County Sheriff's Office Dispatch. Dispatch advised Inv. Burnett that the Rossi .38 special had been reported stolen through the Jackson Police Department.

Inv. Burnett then proceeded to the back right bedroom, and observed a gun case in the left corner of the bedroom which contained a Winchester .22LR. Inv. Burnett observed \$22.00 U.S. Currency and 16 Hydrochlorothiazide pills sitting on top of the dresser in the bedroom. Officers outside the residence recovered approximately \$600.00 in U.S. Currency from Wilder's front pocket.

Investigator Brown advised Wilder of his Miranda Rights and conducted an interview in reference to the narcotics and firearms recovered in the residence. During the interview Wilder stated that the Marijuana and pills recovered from the table in the living room belonged to him. Wilder also stated the weapons belonged to him. Wilder stated he bought the firearms from people in the street. When asked about the fact that they may be stolen Wilder stated "Yeah I know that's possible when I get them from the streets". When asked about specific firearms Wilder stated the Rossi handgun was his and that he purchased from

someone on the street but was unable to provide any identifying information on the subject. Wilder also stated that all currency recovered belonged to him. When asked about employment Wilder stated he had no job just working on vehicles at his residence.

Inv. Burnett placed Wilder in custody for Possession of Controlled Substance with Intent (Marijuana) While in Possession of a Firearm, Possession of Controlled Substance with Intent (Ecstasy) While in Possession of a Firearm, Possession of a Stolen Firearm, and Child Endangerment. Inv. Burnett secured all evidence inside Inv. Brown's vehicle. Inv. Brown gave Wilder's mother a return receipt for all evidence recovered from the residence.

Wilder was transported to the Raymond Detention Center where he was booked and processed without incident. Inv. Burnett logged all evidence into an evidence locker at the downtown Hinds County Sheriff's Office.

Deputy Myers observed a small amount of marijuana in the carpet of the driver's side and the passenger side of the car. At this time Deputy Myers called for a narcotics unit to come and search the car for anything illegal in the vehicle. K-3 with Hinds County Sheriff Office arrived at this location. At this time Deputy Myers released the driver, passenger, vehicle, and all evidence to K-3. At this time K-3 seized the money and asked Deputy Myers to transport Mr. Buchanan to their office for further questioning. K-3 also called for Wards towing to get this vehicle. At this time Deputy Myers went back into service. EOR.

Synopsis: On 3/3/2018, at approximately 23:00 hours, Lt. Mark Morgan encountered Cedric Rolond Cornelius, while conducting a safety check point at West Northside Drive near Frontage Road.

Contributing Circumstances:

Odor of intoxicating beverage, bloodshot and watery eyes, slow/sluggish reactions, thick/slurred speech, and admission to consuming alcohol prior to driving.

Facts:

1. Initial Contact:

On 3/3/2018, at approximately 23:00, hours Lt. Morgan made contact with 2017 Gray Chevrolet Malibu, bearing Florida tag CTPN23, at West Northside Drive at/near the west Frontage Road, the vehicle was checked at a safety check point that was being conducted.

During the initial contact with the defendant, identified as Cedric Cornelius by Mississippi, Driver's License, 800320670. The license was checked through NCIC by Lt. Morgan and determined to be valid.

After speaking with the defendant, Lt. Morgan detected a strong odor of an intoxicating beverage coming from the vehicle, and the defendants breath. Lt Morgan noticed that the defendant had bloodshot watery eyes, slow/sluggish reactions, thick slurred speech. Lt. Morgan asked the defendant if he had been drinking and he said, yes, he had been drinking a friend's house while eating.

Lt. Morgan then offered the defendant a Portable Breath Test, the defendant voluntarily submitted to the PBT, and the result was that there was a presence of alcohol, 0.16%.

The defendant was asked to exit the vehicle, and as he did Lt. Morgan observed the defendant use the door to steady himself as he got out, he was also observed using the side of the vehicle for support as he walked. As the defendant walked to Lt. Morgan's vehicle he was observed staggering as he walked.

2. S.F.S.T.

Lt. Morgan asked the defendant if he had any physical impairments', to which he replied No. Lt. Morgan asked the defendant if he wore glasses and he replied Yes, the defendant was asked to remove his glasses. The defendant was asked if he wore contacts, and he replied No. The defendant was asked to consent to S.F.S.T. and he voluntarily submitted.

The S.F.S.T. was conducted on the level, smooth, and dry part of the Frontage Road, and the line used was the yellow center line.

The First S.F.S.T. was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus, upon beginning this test, Lt. Morgan positioned the defendant in a manner with the feet together and his arms by his side and asked the defendant to remain in that position until further instructed. The defendant acknowledged that he understood the instructions. Lt. Morgan checked the defendant's eyes for equal pupil size, equal tracking, and resting nystagmus. The pupils were equal in size, the eyes were able to track, and there was no resting nystagmus.

The eyes were then checked for lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. Six out of six possible clues were observed. Additionally the eyes were checked for vertical nystagmus and it was not present.

The next S.F.S.T. was the Walk and Turn. The defendant was placed with his left foot on the line and his right foot in front of his left, in a heel-to-toe manner. The defendant was asked to keep his arms by his side, and was asked to remain in that position until told to begin and he acknowledged that he understood. The defendant started too soon, and his feet broke apart, the defendant was then placed back in position and further instructions were given. The defendant was told upon beginning the test, he would take nine heel-to-toe steps down the line, turn in a prescribed manner and take nine heel-to-toe steps back down the line. The defendant was told while walking to watch his feet, count his steps out loud, keep his hands by his side, and do not stop until the task was complete.

The test was demonstrated by Lt. Morgan and the defendant acknowledged that he understood the instructions. The defendant was told to begin. The defendant stepped off the line, (step 3 first nine, and step 7 second nine), raised arms on steps 5, 6, and 7 on the first nine and steps 3, 4, 7, and 8 on the second nine, made improper turn, spin move. Five out of Eight possible clues were observed.

The next S.F.S.T. was the One Leg Stand. The defendant was positioned with his feet together and his arms by his side and asked to remain in that position and not to start the test until instructed to do so. The defendant acknowledged he understood and further instructions were given. Upon beginning the test, the defendant was to raise one leg approximately six inches off the ground with his foot parallel to the ground, keeping both legs straight and arms down to side and watch the elevated foot, the defendant was

to count out loud in the following manner, one thousand one, one thousand two, and one thousand three, and keep counting in this manner until told to stop.

The test was demonstrated and the defendant acknowledged that the instructions were understood. The defendant was wearing tennis shoes. The defendant was told to begin and the defendant raised his right foot, swayed while balancing, used arms for balance, and put foot down on counts 1002, 1007, and 1011. Three out of four possible clues were observed.

3. Breath Testing:

The defendant was then offered the Mississippi Intoxilyzer 8000 to determine the defendant's BrAC%. The observation time was started at 23:00 hours and completed at 23:25 hours. The IP-01E warning was read to the defendant and the defendant submitted to the test. The first breath sample was given at 23:32 hours with result of 0.168%, the second breath sample was given at 23:45 hours with result of 0.175% result of test being 0.16%.

4. Conclusion:

Based on the totality of circumstances, Lt. Morgan believed that the defendant was impaired by ETOH, and unable to operate a motor vehicle safely. The defendant was taken into custody and charged with DUI First Offense. The vehicle was released to Monique Williams, and the defendant was transported to the Raymond Detention Center by Sgt. Cliff Clark.

Synopsis:

On Thursday, 28 September 2017 at approximately 2020 hrs, Deputy Ferrell came into contact with Keith L. Spann (SSN:426-61-4718), who was operating a White 2001 Cadillac Deville (MS HZI 650). After the completion of a DUI investigation, Deputy Ferrell charged the above mentioned for Driving Under the Influence "1st offense."

Facts:

While conducting a traffic safety checkpoint, Deputy Ferrell came into contact with the above said mention vehicle at Northside Drive and Williamson Road. The above mention vehicle was observed backing down Northside Drive and backing into a ditch striking a wooden fence post. The suspect attempted to elude officers by running into the woods but was taken into custody after getting caught in a barbed wire fence at the scene. Upon Deputy Ferrell making contact and was speaking with the suspect, when he came into contact with the odor that is commonly associated with alcohol coming from his breath and person. The suspect also appeared to have red and watery eyes and slurred speech. The suspect admitted to Deputy Ferrell that alcohol was consumed earlier in the evening. The suspect admitted to Deputy Ferrell that he consumed eight beers prior to driving.

SFST:

The suspect refused all test.

Intoxilyzer 8000

Finally, after the twenty minute observation period the suspect was offered the Mississippi Intoxilyzer 8000 to determine his BrAC percentage. After advising the suspect of the IP-O1E warning, the suspect elected to submit to refuse the test.

Conclusion:

The suspect was charged with DUI 1st offense and was later transported to the Raymond Jail by transportation. The vehicle was released to Wards Towing who took possession of the vehicle at the scene.
